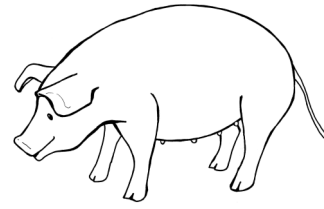


PIGTIONARY
